

PORT OF FURNA - BRAVA ISLAND

Situated 450km off the coast of West Africa, between 14° 48' and 17°12' latitude North, and between 22°40' and 25°22' longitude West, Cape Verde is in the centre of grand trade and navigation routes, in a privileged position for the establishment of a maritime point between the European, African, and American continents. We are prepared to offer alternatives to the main Atlantic maritime transshipment routes. Located on Brava, Cape Verde's smallest, southern-most island, the Port of Furna provides the only access to the island. It is situated in a small, natural bay, to the west of the village of Furna and is framed by the beautiful landscape. The port has the following technical aspects:
