

PORT OF SAL REI - BOA VISTA ISLAND

Situated 450km off the coast of West Africa, between 14° 48' and 17°12' latitude North, and between 22°40' and 25°22' longitude West, Cape Verde is in the center of grand trade and navigation routes, in a privileged position for the establishment of a maritime point between the European, African, and American continents. We are prepared to offer alternatives to the main Atlantic maritime transshipment routes.

The Port of Sal-Rei is located on Boavista, Cape Verde's third largest island. The island has a strong potential for tourism making it necessary to construct larger and better port infrastructures to adequately respond to Boavista's development and the corresponding increase in traffic.
