

PORT INGLES - MAIO ISLAND

Situated 450km off the coast of West Africa, between 14° 48' and 17°12' latitude North, and between 22°40' and 25°22' longitude West, Cape Verde is in the centre of grand trade and navigation routes, in a privileged position for the establishment of a maritime point between the European, African, and American continents. We are prepared to offer alternatives to the main Atlantic maritime transshipment routes.

Located on Maio, a small 270km² island of six thousand inhabitants, Port Inglês only receives inter-island traffic. However, taking into account Maio's potential for tourism, the port is expected to begin receiving international ships. Like all of our ports, Port Inglês plays a large role in reducing the inconveniences caused by Cape Verde's geography.
