



PORT OF VALE DOS CAVALEIROS - FOGO ISLAND

Situated 450km off the coast of West Africa, between 14° 48' and 17°12' latitude North, and between 22°40' and 25°22' longitude West, Cape Verde is in the centre of grand trade and navigation routes, in a privileged position for the establishment of a maritime point between the European, African, and American continents. We are prepared to offer alternatives to the main Atlantic maritime transshipment routes.

This port is located on the island of Fogo, which is known for its big mountains including Cape Verde's only active volcano, which is also the archipelago's tallest mountain. Reconstructed in 2000, Port Vale Cavaleiros is on the north of Fogo, in open waters, with a 4km access road through the steep hills that surrounds the port.
